Pick up is at 3:30 PM, in the parking lot near the Rotary Building. Counselors will bring campers to your car. Drive safely in the parking lot, as we have a lot of campers to deliver to their cars.

Monday, August 8 – Session five begins. The children will participate in dodge ball, whiffle ball and get to know their groups.

Tuesday, August 9 – Minute to Win It – The children will participate in the game from the television show Minute to Win It. We have lots of fun games planned for the afternoon.

Wednesday, August 10 – **Beach Day!** There will be a BBQ picnic with all camps. The campers will be able to swim, canoe and participate in sandcastle building. Your camper will not need a lunch, but please have your camper bring 1 pack of hot dogs. Thank you for your donations. Pick up will be at the beach. E.T. will be picked up at their normal time from the Rotary Building.

Thursday, August 11 – Field trip to Dolphin Cove water park. Please have your child bring sunscreen, swimsuit, towel and extra shirt to swim in if your child burns easily and sack lunch and drink. Extra spending money limited to \$10. We leave Main Beach at 9:00AM and return to the Rotary Building at 3:30PM.

Friday, August 12 – All Day Beach Day. Campers need their sunscreen, swimsuit, towel and an extra shirt to swim in if your child sunburns easily. Children may bring a white t-shirt to tie dye. Campers may bring a sack lunch and drink or money to purchase lunch at the concession stand. Pick up campers at 3:30PM at Main Beach in the parking lot near the baseball field. E.T. campers will be bussed back to the Rotary Building.
