Monday, February 21 is a 1/2 day of school. E.T. will be held at school sites from 6:15AM-8:30AM with breakfast being served from 7:30AM-8:00AM. We will then be open again from noon until 6:15PM. Snack will be served. Your child needs a lunch and drink. Please **NO PEANUTS/PEANUT PRODUCTS** per your school site's directives, as well as no microwaveables! Please check with your child's site for any "specials" planned for the half day. Also, be sure to sign up at your site if you plan on your child attending Noon-6:15PM.

Housekeeping Reminders: Sign your child(ren) in and out of ET each day. Please contact the site supervisor if your child(ren) will be absent from ET. Your ET site telephone number is listed on your monthly calendar. Children must be signed up for field trips at least one week in advance. Not doing so may result in your child not being allowed to participate and increased ET fees. Many of the field trip sites are going to a system where a minimum number of children will be strictly adhered to, whether they attend or not. ET opens at 6:15AM and closes promptly at 6:15 PM. **The late pick up fee is \$10 for the first five minutes and \$1.00 per minute thereafter. Continual lateness may result in your child being dropped from the program. Your ET site telephone number is listed on your monthly calendar. Staff is usually busy with the children and are not able to answer the phone. Please leave a message on the answering machine. If you have an emergency, please contact the Administrative Office at 459-0680 between 8:30AM and 5:00PM, or the Crystal Lake Police Department, 815-455-2313, and have them dispatch a Park Police Officer to contact the site supervisor.**
