### **ORDINANCE 15.16.01**

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A COMBINED ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING SUCH SUMS OF MONEY AS MAY BE DEEMED NECESSARY TO DEFRAY ALL NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CRYSTAL LAKE PARK DISTRICT, CRYSTAL LAKE, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2015 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2016, AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSED FOR WHICH SUCH APPROPRIATIONS ARE MADE, AND THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED FOR EACH OBJECT OR PURPOSE

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CRYSTAL LAKE PARK DISTRICT:

#### SECTION I.

- A. The Board has heretofore caused to be prepared a combined Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance in tentative form, which Ordinance has been conveniently available for public inspection for at least thirty (30) days prior to final action thereon; and
- B. A public hearing was held at the Crystal Lake Park District's office located at 1 East Crystal Lake Avenue, Crystal Lake, Illinois on the 21st day of May 2015 on said Ordinance, notice of said hearing having been given at least one (1) week prior to such hearing by publication in the Northwest Herald, a newspaper published within the Park District; and
- C. That all other legal requirements for the adoption of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of the Park District for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2015 and ending April 30, 2016 have heretofore been performed.

#### SECTION II.

As part of the annual budget, it is stated:

- A. That the estimated cash on hand at the beginning of the fiscal year is \$6,444,905.
- B. That the estimated cash expected to be received during the fiscal year from all sources is \$13,831,105.
- C. That the estimated expenditures contemplated for the fiscal year are \$14,929,460.
- D. That the estimated cash expected to be on hand at the end of the fiscal year is \$5,346,550.
- E. That the estimated amount of taxes to be received by the CRYSTAL LAKE PARK DISTRICT during the fiscal year is \$7,161,080.

#### SECTION III.

That the following sums of money in the total amount of \$14,929,460 or so much thereof as may be authorized by law be and the same are hereby budgeted and appropriated for the corporate purposed of the CRYSTAL LAKE PARK DISTRICT, as hereinafter specified for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2015, and ending April 30, 2016.
