Crystal Lake Park District - Boat Launch Access and Dry Storage Use Waiver and Release of All Claims and Assumption of Risk

Important Information: The Crystal Lake Park District is committed to conducting its recreation programs and activities in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The Crystal Lake Park District continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participants' safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for programs/activities must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities/programs. You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward is physically fit and/or skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity. **Warning of Risk:** Recreational activities are intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of each participant. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury when participating in any recreational activity. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. Depending on the particular activity, participants must understand that certain risks, dangers and injuries due to inclement weather, slip and falls, poor skill level or conditioning, carelessness, horseplay, unsportsmanlike conduct, premises defects, inadequate or defective equipment, inadequate supervision, instruction or officiating, and all other circumstances inherent to indoor and outdoor recreational activities exist. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Crystal Lake Park District to guarantee absolute safety. **Waiver and Release of All Claims:** Please read this carefully and be aware that in signing this form you will be waiving and releasing all claims for injuries you might sustain from using the boat launch or waters of Crystal Lake. "As a resident using the boat launch at Main Beach or West Beach, I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury and I agree to assume the full risk of any injuries, including death, damages or loss which I may sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with the lake. "I agree to waive and relinquish all claims I may have as a result of using the boat launches against the Crystal Lake Park District. "I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless and defend the Crystal Lake Park District and its officers, agents, servants and employees from any and all claims resulting from injuries, including death, damages and losses sustained by me or any third party or parties, or property of the third party or parties arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with the activity of the boat launch or lake." **In the event of an emergency,** I authorize the Crystal Lake Park District to secure any/all necessary medical attention from my accredited hospital and/or ward and further agree that I will be responsible for any and all medical services rendered. I further understand that my signature is required below in order to participate in Crystal Lake Park District programs.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The undersigned boat owner (hereafter "Owner") hereby makes application for a permit to launch and store the boat described on the Dry Storage Permit Application. In consideration for this permit. Owner agrees to comply with the below terms and conditions. as well as all applicable local, state and federal rules, regulations and laws governing the use of the facility. Watercraft Dry Storage Terms and Conditions

The undersigned watercraft owner (hereafter "Owner") hereby makes application for a permit to launch and store the watercraft described on the Dry Storage Permit Application. In consideration for this permit, Owner agrees to comply with the below terms and conditions, as well as all applicable local, state and federal rules, regulations and laws governing the use of the facility.

I. No assumption of care, custody or control by Crystal Lake Park District: Owner is storing the watercraft at Owner's own risk and understands and agrees that by permitting Owner to store the boat on the Crystal Lake Park Property, the Crystal Lake Park District is not assuming the care, custody or control of the watercraft. Further, this agreement does not establish, create or impose joint ownership, care, custody, or control of the boat or any other personal property of the boat owner.

II. Use of Crystal Lake Park District Property by OWNER: Owner is hereby authorized to have access to and use of Crystal Lake Park District property for the storage and launching of the watercraft; provided, however, this use is subject to change at any time should the Crystal Lake Park District determine it needs the Property for its own uses or for any other reason deemed appropriate in the sole discretion of the Crystal Lake Park District.

III. Insurance and Indemnification: Owner shall at its own expense obtain and maintain during the term of this agreement, marine/property coverage insuring the boat against loss or damage to the boat by reason of fire, theft, vandalism, collision or other casualty, in and not less than the actual cash value of the boat with respect to total loss or damage to the boat. The insurer for the Owner shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the Crystal Lake Park District, its officers, officials, employees, volunteers and agents for losses arising from this Agreement. The insurer for the Owner shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the Crystal Lake Park District, its officers, officials, employees, volunteers and agents for losses arising from this Agreement. Further, and to the fullest extent permitted by law, Owner shall protect, indemnify, save, defend and hold harmless the Crystal Lake Park District, its officers, officials, volunteers, employees and agents, from and against any and all liabilities, obligations, claims, damages, penalties, causes of action, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney and paralegal fees, which Crystal Lake Park District and for which its officers, officials, volunteers, employees and agents may become obligated by reason of any accident, bodily injury, death of person, or loss of or damage to tangible property, arising indirectly or directly in connection with or under, or as a result of this agreement.

IV. Security and Supervision: Owner is solely responsible for all supervision of the watercraft and any other personal property brought onto Crystal Lake Park District property and/or stored on the watercraft, and for taking whatever security measures may be warranted for the safety, security, and protection of the watercraft and any other personal property brought onto Crystal Lake Park District property and/or stored on the watercraft. The Crystal Lake Park District shall not be responsible for safeguarding Owner's watercraft or other personal property of owner.

V. Waiver and Release of all Claims and Assumptions of Risk: Owner expressly assumes the risk and legal liability and waives and releases all claims for damages or loss which Owner might sustain as a result of any and all activities connected with and associated with this Agreement (including any and all damage to or loss of any stored property/boat). Owner acknowledges that there are certain risks of damage to its property/boat and Owner voluntarily agrees to assume the full risk of any and all damages or loss regardless of severity that Owner may incur as a result of this Agreement and specifically, storing Owner's boat or other personal property on Crystal Lake Park District property. Owner further agrees to waive and relinquish all claims Owner may have (or accrue to Owner) as a result of this Agreement and storage of Owner's boat/property on Crystal Lake Park District property against the Crystal Lake Park District, including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees. In the event of an emergency, I authorize the Crystal Lake Park District to secure any/all necessary medical attention from my accredited hospital and/or ward and further agree that I will be responsible for any and all medical services rendered. **Warning of Risk:** Boat Gate Users/Motor Boating – There is a risk of serious injury, including death. All hazards and dangers cannot be foreseen. Certain inherent risks include failing to follow safe boating rules and regulations, drinking alcohol, failing to yield the right of way to other boats, traveling too fast for water or weather conditions, overloading the boat, carelessness or horseplay, inexperience, improper installation and maintenance of equipment, collisions between boats, striking natural or artificial surface or subsurface objects, failing to wear life jackets or personal flotation devices, losing control of the boat, acts of God, dangerous weather and water conditions, inadequate instruction/supervision, and all other risks inherent in motor boating.

VI. No Assumption of Liability: Owner further recognizes and agrees that the Crystal Lake Park District, its employees and Commissioners assume no liability for any personal injury to any person using the boating area whether such occurs on the beach or in the water of Crystal Lake and the same are not responsible for any damage to or loss of any personal property.

VII. Abandonment of Property: Owner's watercraft and any other personal property stored on Crystal Lake Park District premises shall be deemed abandoned on October 31 of the same year the permit was acquired. Crystal Lake Park District is relieved of all liabilities for any abandoned property. If Owner abandons the watercraft/property or is dispossessed thereof by process of law, or otherwise, title to any watercraft/personal property belonging to Owner and left on the premises shall be deemed to have been transferred to the Crystal Lake Park District. Crystal Lake Park District shall have the right to remove and dispose of such watercraft/property without liability therefore to Owner or to any person claiming under Owner, and shall have no need to account therefore. Crystal Lake Park District may retain the boat/property as its property or may dispose of the boat/property through sale, donation or in such other manner as the Crystal Lake Park District, in its sole discretion may determine. Any proceeds derived from the sale or other disposition of such property shall be the property of the Crystal Lake Park District.

VIII. Assignment and Transfer: This agreement and permit is non-transferable and may not be assigned to any other party without the express written approval of the Crystal Lake Park District.

IX. Miscellaneous: Owner further agrees that in the event of his/her failure to abide by the Rules and Regulations on his/her part or of any person occupying or authorized to use his/her boat, that this permit is subject to immediate suspension and/or revocation at the sole discretion of the Crystal Lake Park District. Only one boat per family unless space is available. Motor boats are prohibited.
