Dear Parents and Campers,

Welcome to PeeWee Camp session 2! We have a lot of exciting activities planned, which include swim lessons, a trip to Dancing Horses, camp themed crafts, a campfire at Veteran Acres and an all camps "Minute to Win It" day at the Rotary Building. Please see the "Reminders" down below for what your child needs daily. If you have not done so, please finish your Campdoc forms as soon as possible. Your child will not be able to attend camp until we have received your emergency information.

If you have purchased a Punch Pass you will need to scan your key fob when your child attends camp. **You must email or call PW Camp by 3:00 P.M. the day before you plan on attending. If you do not contact us in advance, your child will not be able to attend camp.**

Reminders:

- Please remember to send your child with a lunch & drink or money to purchase one daily. Due to being at the beach we cannot provide one for your child. If your child does not bring a lunch or money to purchase one, we will be calling you to bring one.
- No peanut butter/peanut products
- Drop-off and pick up sites vary daily. Please read the newsletter carefully
- Pick up at Main Beach is in the parking lot near the baseball field
- A.M. & P.M. E.T. is held at Coventry School every day
- Please remember to notify the camp counselor if your child will be picked up early or is going to be absent from camp.
- Any medication must be brought to camp with the appropriate paper work and in it's original container.
- **Send gym shoes, sunscreen, bug spray and water bottle daily**
- Send swimsuit on days we will be swimming
- No electronics are allowed at camp
- **Pack extra clothes in case of "Potty Accidents"**
- Buses leave Main Beach to pick up site @ 12:15 p.m. with the exception of field trip days and all day beach day

Drop Off Procedures

When dropping off @ Main Beach, please walk your child across the street and directly to their counselor.

Please do not drop off before 8:45 A.M.
(We use the time before camp to prep for our day)

Pick Up Procedures

Pick up starts at 3:30 P.M.

All parents must remain in their vehicles. The counselor will bring your child to you for signing out.

- @ Coventry please pull in front of the building to line up
- @ Rotary please pull in front of the building to line up
- @ Main Beach please pull to the right in the parking lot, circle past the large planter, and move towards the baseball field.

Please be patient with our new routine. We want to ensure all the children are safe during this busy time.
