Welcome to session 2 of Teen Camp! Our camp is held at Main Beach in the "Teen Camp" room. To get to our room, please enter through the front door at the far left side of the building. Once inside, you will be in the concession area, turn left down the hallway and our room is on the left side across from the bathrooms. **Pick up is at the front by the street light in the beach parking lot.**

If you have not done so, please finish your Campdoc forms as soon as possible. You will not be allowed to attend camp until we have your emergency information.

If you have purchased a Punch Pass you will need to scan your key fob when your child attends camp. **You must email or call Teen Camp by 3:00 P.M. the day before you plan on attending. If you do not contact us in advance, your child will not be able to attend camp.**

If you have a Lunch Card with funds still on it from last year you can use it.

Some Friendly Reminders:

- Drop off is at Main Beach. Please pull into the parking lot. You may walk your child into the front gates or they may cross themselves. Counselors will be waiting for the campers at the front of the building.
- Drop off is at Rotary or Coventry School if your child is in A.M. E.T. They will then be bused over to Main Beach.
- Pick up is at Main Beach unless noted otherwise in the newsletter. We will walk the campers to the parking lot by the streetlight/flower pot. Pick up is at Rotary if your child is in P.M. E.T.
- If your child will be riding a bike to/from camp you need to fill out a bike form.
- You must always sign your child out.
- If someone not listed on emergency form is going to pick up please inform us.
- Please call Teen Camp at **(815)355-7097** if your camper will be absent from camp or E.T. Your child's counselor will be calling you if we do not receive a call.
- Needed daily: lunch or money to purchase one, swimsuit & towel, gym shoes, sunscreen & bug spray
